Iria-ini Farms are located in Mathira division of Nyeri North District. Surrounded by the scenic highlands west of Mt. Kenya, Iria-ini is situated in an area famed for producing some of the world's finest coffees.

Iria-ini FCS comprises three factories: Kamunyaka, Kiamwangi and Miiri with the head offices located at Kamunyaka factory.



Quality Profile

Iria-ini's Arabica coffee grown at high altitude is produced by small-scale farmers, who pick every bean by hand. Their coffee is pulped, fermented, washed and dried on raised beds. Each bean is inspected for defects during the controlled sun-drying process. The result is a full, deep, rich coffee, with blackcurrant flavor notes, a rich winy taste, and strong lingering chocolate sensation not found anywhere else in the world. It's coffee worth tasting!
